## Mark Goldstein, MD, CPI

Dr. Goldstein was born and raised in New York City. He graduated from Colgate University, receiving a BA with a major in biophysics. He obtained his medical degree from Emory University School of Medicine in Atlanta. Upon graduation, he completed residencies in both internal medicine at College of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey/Robert Wood Johnson and neurology at Stanford University. He is board certified in both internal medicine and neurology. After relocating to South Florida, he joined a busy clinical neurology practice that he helped grow to 6 neurologists.

Dr. Goldstein began participating in clinical trials in the late 1990s. To date, he has participated in over 150 clinical trials and was the principal investigator for more than 125 of those trials. Most of these trials were conducted at JEM Research Institute, of which he is a founding member, President, and Co-Medical Director. Under his guidance, JEM Research Institute has grown into a substantial clinical research site currently employing more than 40 people and conducting over 20 active trials at any one time, many of which focus on progressive cognitive decline.

As a clinical neurologist, Dr. Goldstein was an affiliated Assistant Clinical Professor of Neurology at the University of Miami. As a researcher, he is a certified principal investigator as well as a fellow of the Academy of Physicians in Clinical Research.

Dr. Goldstein has served on the board of directors of the Medical Specialists of The Palm Beaches, the largest multispecialty medical group in Palm Beach County. He has also been a member of the executive committee as well as chairman of the credentials committee at JFK Hospital in Atlantis. He has been both the Chief of the Division of Neurology and the Director of the Comprehensive Stroke Center at JFK Hospital.
